120 DAYS OF HARVEST 550,000 RESPOND TO THE GOSPEL

The first four months of 2019 certainly proved to be a very fruitful season for SWEA/GFE. In addition to the field evangelism ministry that goes on every day, the teams also conducted some very successful special projects. In January, the Kenya team joined with Shad and Sheila in a project in Moshi, Tanzania, which resulted in nearly 44,000 people praying to receive Jesus. In February, Evangelist Livingston Wambua (Kenya) led a small team into a remote desert area of Kenya to reach people who had literally never heard about Jesus. They had to walk for miles because the vehicle could not manage the terrain. During those days over 11,000 people responded. In March, Evangelist Kevin Chumba took a team to the Kenyan town of Bungoma for an intensive time of evangelism in schools, markets, prisons, and film shows. They saw nearly 50,000 people pray to receive Jesus. In addition, 75 men were trained in field evangelism. In the Congo, in April, Evangelist Oyelo Ulimwengu traveled to the interior remote town of Kindu to conduct evangelistic meetings and field evangelism training. It is an area that is dominated by witch doctors and spiritism. In all, over 11,000 people came to Christ and 100 pastors and evangelists were trained in field evangelism. In Nigeria, during March and April, Evangelist Jonah Obina, and his team of 34 volunteers, conducted scores of evangelistic meetings in which over 100,000 people responded. And, on and on it goes. During the first 120 days of this year, the teams averaged preaching the Gospel to 5500 people per day. Despite, rain, muddy roads, vehicle breakdowns, lack of equipment, satanic opposition, and many other challenges, they persist day by day in getting the Gospel out. As a result, tens of thousands of people are coming into the Kingdom of God every week. And, to all of you, our faithful friends who help keep this work going on day by day, we again say THANK YOU!!

Departure day is drawing near for campaign number 190 in Kisii, Kenya. This will be our Kenya project number 66. Preparations are underway, and we are believing God for another great harvest of souls for His Kingdom. We are excited to once again have our daughter-in-law, Lynn Williams, going with us. She was a great blessing to the Nakuru project last June, and we are looking forward to her being with us again. School assemblies, open-air venues, and prison meetings are being organized. And, of course, film shows will be conducted each evening. In addition, a field evange-lism training seminar will be held for pastors and evangelists in the Kisii area. We are working in conjunction with SWEA/GFE pastor/evangelist, Daniel Khatera in this project. He has been stationed in Kisii for the past 20 years. As always, there are many areas of this project that need fervent prayer. We need clear **dry weather**, God's provision of **health and safety**, **Holy Spirit power** in proclaiming the Gospel, and **financial provision** to cover the expenses of the project.
